Totland Parish Council would like to thank all who have dropped into the Parish Office complimenting the area around Stokes Green and Turf Walk. This work is ongoing and Councillors are very pleased residents like this project. Work will recommence now the cold weather is over.

Colwell Common – Since April last year the Common has been used most months for community events and Councillors have agreed to have a container on the Common for storage. This will allow the Parish Council to store tables, chairs and barrier fencing as an example, so it will be ready to use rather than being stored in the Clerk's office.

Car Boots – A reminder that the Car Boots on Colwell Common will commence on Saturday 14th April with sellers setting up from 8.30am and buyers arriving at 9.00am. No pre-booking is required just turn up.

Police Beat Surgeries – The Parish Council have been able to secure two surgeries each month until July. The dates for April are as follows: Wednesday 4th April 10am – 11am and Wednesday 18th April 11am – 12 noon. Garden Bags: This service is no longer available. The new scheme that has now been launched means residents can now have their garden waste collected from their home. By subscribing for a 240 litre wheeled bin or hessian sacks to be picked up from the kerbside for £60.00/year. The scheme is in partnership with Amey and the Isle of Wight Council who have said it will make gardening easier and save having to load the car up with heavy bags of wet garden waste.
