

News and Updates from Totland Parish Council August 2023

We are all looking forward to a wonderful Summer and would like to highlight a couple of points to keep us all safe.

- 1. BBQ's & Fires: We urge all not to have any BBQ's or fires around Totland, especially during the summer months and no disposable BBQ's please. Help us by reminding any family members or visitors of this.
- 2. Personal Watercraft Vehicles: New regulations from 31st March 2023 are in place and these can be found on our website <u>Jet Ski Rules and Regulations</u>. Reporting information is also on our website. During the summer months many PWC users come to the Island, Colwell and Totland included, and there is no law stopping them doing this. They do have to abide by the rules and the Marine Police can help with this.

Summer Biffa Bins: It has been agreed that the large additional bins supplied for the summer holidays by Biffa and financed by Totland Parish Council, through the local precept, was not working in the manner it had been intended and therefore will not be in place this summer. The amount of additional rubbish has increased enormously, and we have witnessed and challenged people who have thought it was okay to use this facility to get rid of their own general waste and fly tip. These bins could only be emptied twice a week and on days when they are not emptied the rubbish piles high in and around the bin, to the point where the lid would not shut. Councillors agreed this made the area look unkept and certainly unpleasant for the holiday season. Most of these bags are torn open overnight with the contents left over the paths and road. Councillors have tried hard to encourage people to take their rubbish home with them and to not leave additional bags when the bins are full to improve our area.

With all taken into consideration, Councillors agreed they would not provide the two large Biffa bins this year. We will continue to promote taking rubbish home and to not leave rubbish bags around the bins. Please help us by not adding additional rubbish to the already full bins.

Tidy Totland: We are launching Tidy Totland around the village and we will be asking businesses and residents to take pride in our Community by keeping it clear of litter.

Planning applications have been submitted for the Recreation Ground toilets and Cycle Track and the Dog Agility area works will commence shortly.

The memorial benches have been surveyed and sadly we will be removing several as they are beyond economical repair. Others will receive remedial repairs to include staining.

August Office Opening:

The office is closed for annual leave from Monday 7th August and will reopen on Tuesday 29th August. Emails will be picked up daily and dealt with on an urgent basis.

Safety Concerns: We are still waiting to hear back from the Isle of Wight Council for the consideration of removing 4 parking spaces in the Colwell Chine Road car park.
