Councillors would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a happy and safe Christmas.

Christmas Opening: The Parish Office will close on Thursday 21st December at 12.30pm and reopen on Wednesday 3rd January 2024 at 9.30am.

We have again supplied the school children of St Saviours Christmas baubles for them to decorate for our Christmas tree on Cokes Green. Year 5 and 6 decorate these big baubles and they are all beautiful, a big thank you to the teachers who help to make this happen, we all enjoy this moment. Once completed we will ask them to display on the tree before the lights are switched on.

Public Toilets - Colwell public toilets: Councillors are updating these facilities over the winter which as you can imagine is very costly and therefore it is important when making decisions we get this right the first time. Works should start this month in order for them to be ready in the Spring 2024. The disabled toilet will be available for all to use whilst these works are in progress.

Recreation Ground

The new swings on the Recreation ground have been finished and ready to use. There was no waste as we reused everything. This year we have repaired/replaced most of the play builder area, repainted all the play equipment and replaced the swings.

Remembrance Sunday: Thank you to the West Wight Men in Sheds for putting up the lamp post poppies this year along The Broadway. This year the Royal British Legion West Wight Branch Annual Service of Remembrance was held at the Freshwater War Memorial, next year, 2024, it will be in Totland and then 2025 Yarmouth.

2024/2025 Budget preparation has started and discussions to support the West Wight Sports and Community Centre, West Wight Nursery and Community Connector have remained popular. The Parish Council has also been supporting the Post Office, however, this may not be viable for this year as the service changes and the ever increasing costs to run.
