The Annual Parish Meeting will be Tuesday 14th May at 6.30pm in the Church Hall on The Broadway. We will have guest speakers from FYTBus, Men in Sheds and the Archive Group. All Totland residents are welcome to attend to hear what the Parish Council has been doing over the last year and plans for this year.

Mosaics. Hopefully by now you have all seen phase one of the Community Mosaic project at the Totland Beach toilets. This has been achieved by an Awards for All Grant and the many volunteers who come along every week to be a part of this project. We have now started phase two and if you would like to be part of this project come along on Tuesday afternoons at 2pm.

Car Boot Sales on Colwell Common: The season has begun and each Saturday until 28th September there will be a Car Boot on Colwell Common, (except 29th June and 31st August). Weather plays a huge part with this and we will keep you informed on the Parish Council Facebook account. The Parish Council will be supporting the West Wight Nursery, 1st Freshwater/Totland Scout Group, West Wight Sports & Community Centre and the West Wight Men in Sheds with these events. Please come along and support these groups. Sellers can set up from 8.30am with buyers coming along from 9.00am.

Poo Watch – This has been a joint initiative with the residents of Totland and the Parish Council. By now each household in Totland should have received a form which gives you the opportunity to report any person who is not picking up after their dog. We are not looking for names and addresses but more locations and times of where and when this is happening, and you need to have witnessed this; this is very important as we cannot act on hearsay. A description of the person and dog and the road names are what we need. These forms can be dropped into the Parish Office at any time and more forms are also available. You can also email the Clerk.

What Happens to this information?

This information will be gathered onto a database and once a pattern emerges the Environmental Officers will be informed.

If you have any questions relating to Poo Watch, please do not hesitate to contact the Clerk. We have already identified two offenders and are currently working with the Environmental Officer.

Men in Sheds we have two sites for the Men in Sheds, West Wight will be on the Recreation Ground. They are currently repairing the container and are hoping to have a workshop and kitchen/rest area. Whilst this work is being completed they meet at the Corner Room at Fort Victoria every Thursday. We also have Totland Men in Sheds who meet at Turf Walk on a Thursday between 2pm and 4pm. West Wight Churches Youth Project have been awarded a grant to continue the good work they do with the Youth in Totland. They meet weekly at the West Wight Sports & Community Centre and offer a variety of activities.

Lift the Lid Project – Live from the Parish Hall. Totland Parish Council are working on this project as partners and the artist Julie Myer is actively meeting local people. An event will be held in the Church Hall on The Broadway on Saturday 22nd June 2019 between 1pm and 5pm.

Meet & Eat This will continue on the first Friday of each month and the next one will be Friday 3rd May and 7th June. They meet at St Saviours Holy Family Centre which is on the FYTBus route B round. All are welcome.
