Consultation Church Hall - Totland Residents only

The Parish Council have been in discussions, since 2007 on and off, regarding the purchase of the Church Hall and to improve this facility for the Community. We want to provide a community asset including a Parish Office that will benefit the residents of Totland. This will remain as a community hall and the Parish Council will be looking to provide a better and up to date facility for all. Smaller rooms will also be available to hire as well as a large hall for shows/pantomimes. An in-depth consultation will take place involving residents asking what they would like to see within this asset and will be strongly led by the Community. The land behind the hall has also been considered and the Parish Council are putting together a housing needs survey with a plan to have affordable housing on the site for local people. In order for this to move forward the first stage includes asking residents for their support. Please drop into the Parish Office on The Broadway and pick up a questionnaire.
