

## News and Updates from Totland Parish Council October 2018

Following on from last month's updates regarding the vandalism we have not seen any further disruption, but we will keep monitoring this with the local Neighbourhood Police Team. We continue to ask you to ring 101 if you see anything troublesome in Totland as reporting them will help keep are village safe.

**Skatepark.** The annual Skatepark Competition, which is run by Totland and Freshwater Parish Council, was again successful this year even though we had to change the dates due to the weather. Regular works and maintenance are required to the Skatepark and the Committee want to work with local people to ensure this happens smoothly and safely.

**West Wight Parade.** Although cancelled in July we managed to secure a second date and this went ahead on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> September. Councillors would like to thank everybody who came along and supported this event and also thank the many people who helped with the event on the day. Island Roads were very good helping us with the change of date for the road closures along with HSS who were on site throughout the Parade with the signs. Sydenhams looked after our float this year towing the float to six around the Island Carnivals and well done to our Queens who looked great.

The committee work very hard to lay on this Parade and we are always in need of volunteers to help marshal this event. If you would like to be involved next year, please let the Parish Clerk know. The Isle of Wight Pearl sponsored the float this year and the Committee will meet later this month to ascertain what our theme will be for next year. If any businesses would like to sponsor the float, please again get in touch with the Parish Clerk.

**Saturday 11st August 2018 - Art & Craft on Colwell Common.** We had some amazing artists come to this event displaying their work and on speaking to them Councillors will look at holding this event back on Turf Walk. We do not have the same luxury parking facilities on Turf Walk but Councillors will re-evaluate this.

**Upcoming Car Boots – Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> October**. This is the last month for this year we will be running Car Boots on the Common, sadly this month we have no refreshments on site. We are attracting good sellers and ask for you to continually support. Sellers are welcome from 8.30am and buyers at 9am. As this is an outdoor event they are all weather permitting. No pre-booking is required just turn up. This year the Parish Council have been supporting two groups, West Wight Nursery and the 1<sup>st</sup> Freshwater/Totland Scout Group.
