Christmas Fair 2023

The Christmas Fair held on Colwell Common last month was very well attended even though it was incredibly cold. Thank you to all who did come out and we hope you enjoyed. The fire pit was especially needed, and we enjoyed the carols led by Richard and Hazel Britton. The Ukelele Group, West Wind and Bay Wailers were also fabulous with their amazing performances and of course Huxley who entertains both children and adults. The Christmas Fair will go ahead again this year on Friday 29th November 2024.

2024/2025 Budget

Preparation for the 2024/2025 budget has started with Councillors wanting to continue the financial support for the West Wight Sports & Community Centre, Community Connector and West Wight Nursery. The Beach Buoys would also remain at Widdick Chine and Colwell.

Further discussions are required for the Church Hall and Post Office. We have reached an agreement on the purchase price of the Church Hall and solicitors are dealing with the paperwork currently. The Totland Bay Post Office has been financially supported for the last three years and although fairly well used the Parish Council agreed to support this for our community users. Councillors would like residents feedback as a request to increase the financial support has been received. It should be noted this remains a satellite branch and is very much dependant on another Post Office remaining open along with Community Action who also financially support.

The upgrade to Colwell toilets is ongoing, and the new toilets to Totland Recreation Ground is also in place, and as previously mentioned, this will not increase the precept as they will both be pay as you use.

An Open Day in the Parish Office will go ahead this month, date will be advertised, and we urge Totland residents to come along and talk with Councillors.

Open Spaces

Tree surveys starting with Turf Walk will be carried out over the next few months and as soon as the weather brightens the memorial benches will be a priority. We had hoped to carry out these works last year, however, the play equipment on the Recreation ground had much needed repairs and replacements carried out. Trees had been replaced on Colwell Common during December and these are already coming on.
