

News and Updates from Totland Parish Council March 2020

Parish Council meeting changes. From January the Parish Council have agreed to meet on the $2^{\rm nd}$ Monday and bi-monthly. Therefore, dates for 2020 are as follows: Monday 9th March, Monday $11^{\rm th}$ May, Monday 13th July, Monday $14^{\rm th}$ September, Monday $9^{\rm th}$ November. Planning meetings will be called as and when required with Extra Ordinary meetings being called in between should they be required. The Annual Parish Meeting will be held at the end of May, date to follow.

Precept 2020/2021: The Parish Council have set the precept and have kept this as low as possible. The increase will be just over 5% and Councillors continue to source and give good value for money with the works, events and activities they organise around Totland. Support remains for the West Wight Sports & Community Centre along with other groups in Totland.

Open Spaces: Phase 2 of our Stokes Green project will start March/April and we will be looking for volunteers to help plant. If you would like to be involved please let the Clerk know at the Parish Office, details below.

Car Boot Sales: We can now confirm the Car Boots on Colwell Common with return this year from Saturday 4th April until 26th September. There is one date in August when Messy Church will take over the Common for the Messy Church day. The Parish Council will be supporting the West Wight Nursery, 1st Freshwater/Totland Scout Group, West Wight Sports & Community Centre and West Wight Men in Sheds with these events. Please come along and support this event whether to you buying or selling.

Men in Sheds continues to run in Totland and they are open on Thursdays between 2pm and 4pm at Turf Walk (weather dependent), all are welcome.
