Totland Recreation Parking: It has been a year since the signs were installed and I am pleased to say most residents abide by these rules, but sadly not all. The Totland Recreation Ground car parking area should not be used by local people as a parking space or even a second car parking space or for vehicles that are either SORN or do not hold a current MOT. The area is for users of the facilities only and no overnight parking is allowed for any vehicles.
