Remembrance Sunday: This year the Royal British Legion West Wight Branch Annual Service of Remembrance will be held at Totland War Memorial on Sunday 11th November. The parade will muster on the Broadway by the War Memorial at 10.45am. The Last Post will be sounded at 11.00am followed by a two minutes silence and Reveille. The wreath laying ceremony will then take place and on completion, there will be a Remembrance Sunday service at Christ Church.
