	will continue pushing this forward.				
	The Broadway double yellow lines and new signage has now been completed.				
	Rubbish accumulating on the seawall again in the Pill Box. Clerk will contact Police as during lockdown nobody should be using this area. The Isle of Wight Council will be asked to clear				
	the area again.				
	Rubbish from Totties has been raised. There are several bins in this area and the Clerk will				
	send a letter with a poster to the shop asking for them to consider displaying and helping to encourage their customers to throw their rubbish responsibly.
