Proposal: The two holm oak trees that are the subject of this application are seen to be an important arboreal feature in Eden Place and the surrounding area. The reasons for the trees removal detailed in the application are not sufficient to warrant the felling. The issues raised such as the clearance of the road and leaf litter can be managed through other means. Issues such as shade to the sheds, parking area and road would not be a sufficient reason to remove the two trees and are not to be at a level that might be problematic. For these reason the council cannot justify giving consent to the two trees removal at this time.

Colwell Cottage on Colwell Lane – Fence is too high by the highway and planning permission should have been obtained prior to erecting. Enforcement have been notified and have looked into this. A response has now been received which informed the Clerk the enforcement case has been closed on this matter on the following basis:

"Colwell Lane is a small rural lane with boundaries being predominantly hedgerow. The kerbs and fencing does cause some urbanisation but seeks to formalise the boundary. In addition, the fence is of good quality materials and does not cause any highway safety concerns.

Having regard to the above whilst the erection of the fence and kerbstones are a technical breach of planning control and should a planning application be submitted it would be likely to be supported. On this basis it is not expedient or in the public interest to consider formal enforcement action as such the planning enforcement case should be closed on this matter."

Councillors would like to know if the area between the kerbstone and the fence will be planted?

It was noted that FYTBus use this route and they feel the area is adequate for

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their bus to get through.

Stoats Farm – a large amount of tarmac has been delivered to form an access road within the campsite and it has been noted that this will not help with drainage to the surrounding properties. Clerk to contact planning/enforcement. The road is also collapsing outside Stoats Farm. Island Roads repaired an area but the road is collapsing behind this repair.

They are also selling ice cream at the entrance and this is causing traffic issues with customers pulling over on the road.

Hawkridge Manor Farm building works – no feedback has been received regarding the drainage concerns expressed by the Councillors. It was noted this had not been approved to date.

2. Isle of Wight Councillor for Totland & Colwell – Chris Jarman

The report was circulated with no questions from Councillors.

Councillor Jarman continued with informing Councillors he had almost finished all the training and is also busy helping to write the new policies for the 'Alliance Group'. They want to introduce local representation on planning and asked if Councillors would support this, all agreed that this would be a good idea and would value having time to express support or objections for planning in Totland. A roads and speeding consultation Island wide would also be carried out shortly and this would be a short consultation. Councillor Jarman recommended Councillors start looking now to see what speeds road could meet in Totland. Councillor Jarman also spoke about a puzzle trail idea for Totland working with the library. Councillors agreed to invite the Library to the July meeting to hold a short presentation.

3. Open Spaces

T6 Summers Lane to Summers Court footpath edge maintenance. The Parish Council has been asked if they want to take this over.

Further enquiries need to be made and to find out who currently maintains the verges.

There are several elm trees on the entrance of T1 that are dead and Island Roads has contacted the Clerk asking them to be made safe. Clerk to contact tree surgeon to remove.

Island Roads to be contacted to cut back:

T1 Colwell Chine Road to Fort Warden Road.

T14 Cliff Road to York Lane

Heath Meadows – pinch point needs widening.

A quotation has been requested to clear the roundabout on The Broadway and replant.

4. Clerk

No update on the Welcome Back Funding – they were hoping to update by the end of May.

Widdick Chine bench was replaced a couple of years ago by the Parish Council with the permission of Rights of Way. I have been contacted by the original purchaser wants to add the original name to the bench. This bench was purchased by a local couple who have said no.

The bench came under Rights of Way and it was damaged and needed removing.

The step at the bottom of Widdick Chine needs replacing, Clerk to contact Rights of Way.

- c. There has been no confirmation of the award for the grant applied for these buoys.
- d. The Isle of Wight Council will arrange for the Colwell buoys to be in week commencing 21st June.

A new hosepipe has been order by the Timebank and the Clerk will reimburse payment for this. All plots are now full. CJ has two spaces if the Parish Council would like to nominate anyone.
